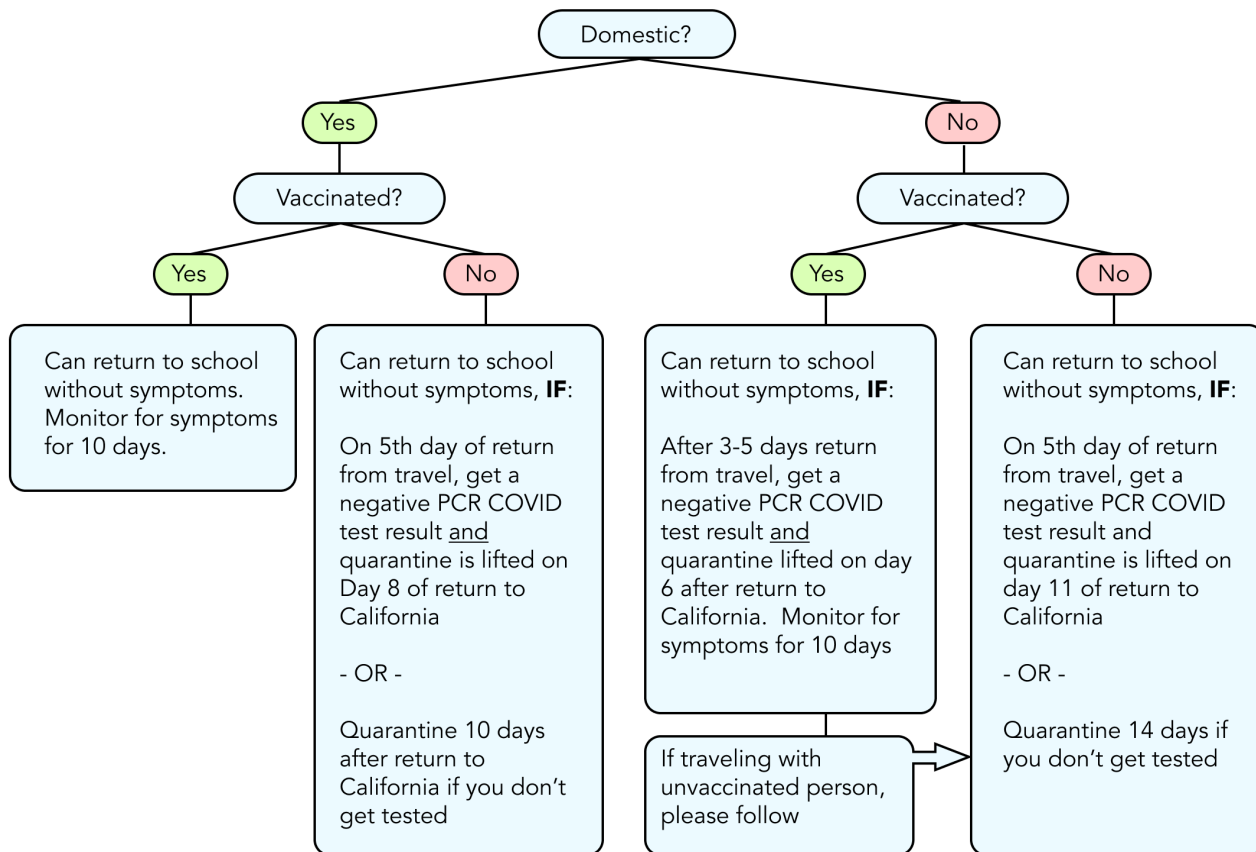




Updated Travel Policy - November 19, 2021

Greetings from Hope! I want to provide you with the most recent updates on our school's travel policy. Today's update supersedes the original policy which was released on November 17, 2020. This updated policy is based on the November 8, 2021 [travel guidelines from the CDC](#) and the California Department of Public Health.

When can I return to school after travel out of California?



With the pandemic in an upsurge in many parts of the world, I would like to discourage you from international travel. If international travel is essential and you are **fully vaccinated**, please follow the policy below:

A Fully Vaccinated International Traveler: After 3-5 days return from travel, get a PCR COVID test. If the result is negative, quarantine can be lifted on day 6 day after returning to California. If traveling with unvaccinated people, please: Get a PCR test on 5th day of returning, If the test result is negative, quarantine is lifted on day 11 after return to California -OR- quarantine 14 days if you don't get tested. Monitor for symptoms for 10 days. ****If the test is positive, isolate for 14 days from onset of symptoms and get a second PCR test 5 days after symptoms subside.**

Special Notes:

HOPE students who are not vaccinated will need to be quarantined for 7 days after returning from outside of California or domestic travel. Unvaccinated individuals are discouraged from international travel.

HOPE students will also need to quarantine for 7 days if unvaccinated visitor(s) from outside California are staying with the student's household.
